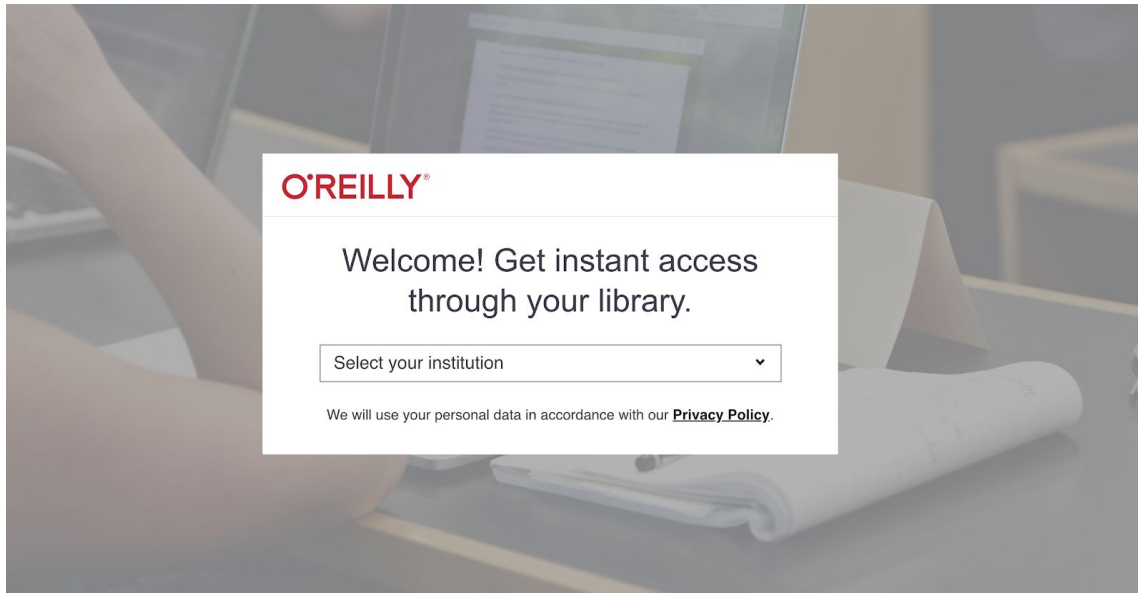


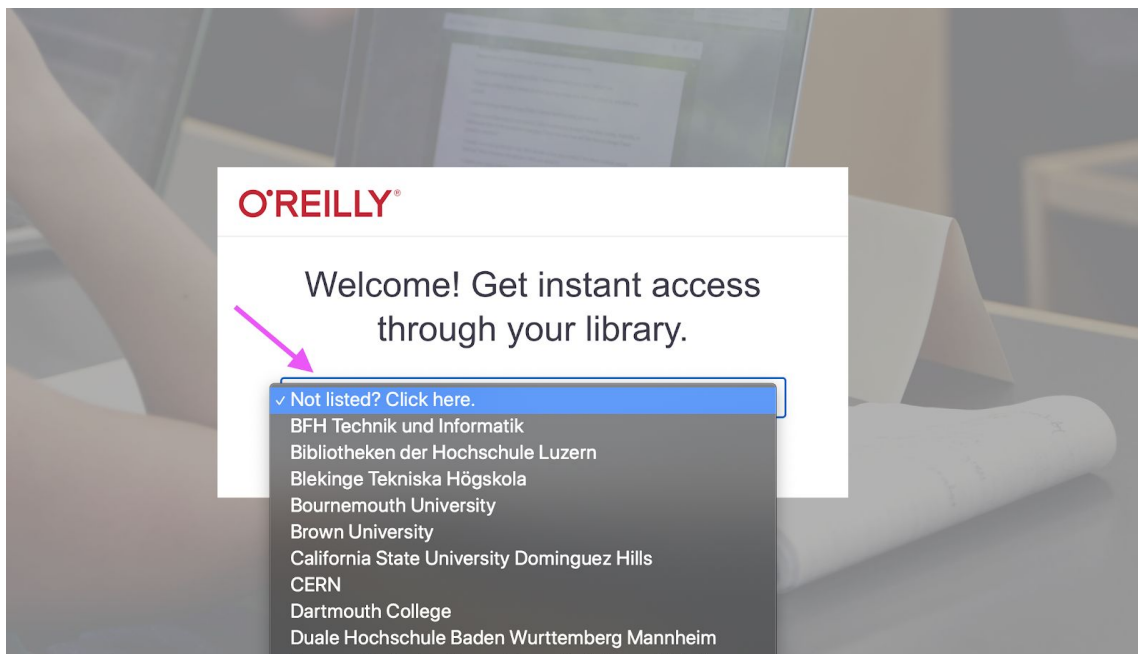


1. From the AZ database list, you're prompted to this page. Stevens is not listed on the Library List.
